Camp for people with Disability**
organised at Shri Ashrivad Viklang Center,
Sayla on 24th and 25th December, 11.

Students and Faculty of School of Physiotherapy, RK University, Rajkot (www.rku.ac.in) participated and celebrated World Disability Day (3rd December, 11) with **Disability Support Physiotherapy Camp** organized by Lions Club of Tardev, Mumbai and Shri Raj Subhag Ashrum, Sayla at Shri Ashrivad Viklang Center, Sayla, Surendranagar, Gujarat on 24th and 25th December, 11.



In divine presence of Shri BhaiShri, Mrs. Minalben Shah, Mr. Vikrumbhai Shah, Dr. Saroj Sanghavi, Physiotherapy camp and Mobility Park was inaugurated at Shri Ashrivad Viklang Center, Sayla. It was nice opportunity to interact with Dr. Punani, (IIM-A fellow) Director, Blind Association of India during the event.

More than 700 patients from rural areas of Chotila to Limdi districts had availed an advantage of the camp. The large number of patients with physical and functional disability (FD) from musculoskeletal (mainly degenerative joint disorders) and



neuromuscular disease & disorders were participated in the camp and availed the free physiotherapy consultation, diagnosis, and treatment. Patients with moderate to severe disability were provided free orthosis to improve activities of daily livings (ADLs).



Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation was aimed to improve Quality of Care (QOC) and Quality of Life (QOL) of patients who are abundantly lacking with Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR). Counseling session was mainly emphasized on health education, hygiene and ergonomic advises besides life style



modification for every patient. Students had also provided treatment program for needy patients at Physiotherapy Department of Ashrivad Viklang Centre, Sayla.



Students had an opportunity to learn and experience the principles of CBR for disabled during the camp and interaction with Mr. Jadavbhai, Director, Ashrivad Viklang Centre, Sayla. School of Physiotherapy highly appreciates Lions Club of Tardev,



Mumbai and Shri Raj Subhag Ashrum, Sayla for extending an opportunity for students to serve physical Disabled for humanity. Students had an opportunity to train under senior and leading clinical physiotherapist Dr. Saroj Sanghavi, Lions club of Tardev, Mumbai during the camp.
